ABOUT BANGLADESH INSTITUTE OF BANK MANAGEMENT (BIBM)

BIBM is an apex educational, training and research institution which is supported and supervised by the Bangladesh Bank, almost all the banks and a few financial institutions of Bangladesh. It was established in 1974 under the Societies Act, 1860. It primarily provides training to the mid and senior-level executives of banks and financial institutions. Besides, it conducts workshops, seminars, roundtable discussions, conferences and undertakes research on banking and allied fields regularly. BIBM arranges orientation programs on the banking sector of Bangladesh for the CEOs of foreign commercial banks in Bangladesh. It also offers certification programs in different areas of banks. These include Certified Expert in Risk Management (CERM); Certified Expert in NPL Management and Investment (CENPL)- jointly with Frankfurt School of Finance and Management, Germany; Certified Expert in Credit Management (CECM); Certified Expert in Trade Services (CETS); Certified Expert in E-Banking (CEEB); Certified Expert in Anti-Money Laundering and Financial Crime (CEAF); and Certified Islamic Banking and Finance Professional (CIBFP). Moreover, BIBM also launched two certification programs titled 'Certificate in Commercial Credit Analytics (CICC)', and 'Certificate in SME Credit (CiSMEC) in collaboration with Moody's Analytics.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM AND DHAKA SCHOOL OF BANK MANAGEMENT (DSBM)

BIBM started Masters in Bank Management (MBM) program in 1997 with the affiliation of National University. In 2021, the program celebrated 25 years of its journey. The MBM Program is a 2 years and 4 months professional postgraduate program for those who plan career in banking and allied fields. In 2006, BIBM introduced MBM-Evening program mainly for the bankers and other professionals. After the successful completion of 16 batches of MBM and 7 batches of MBM-Evening, the program has been affiliated with the University of Dhaka from the year 2012. BIBM has established Dhaka School of Bank Management (DSBM) for smooth running of the program. Both the MBM and MBM-Evening programs are conducted under the same regulations and syllabus approved by the University of Dhaka. So far 1624 graduates completed their degree under these programs. Almost all of them are now working in different banks and financial institutions. Some of them have already reached the top-level management of the banks.

Admission Process

CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

A graduate in any field of study with minimum 16 years of schooling and at least one first division/class (CGPA 3.75 in a 5-point scale or 3.0 in a 4-point scale) and no third division/class (CGPA below 2.813 in a 5-point scale or below 2.5 in a 4-point scale) in any certificate/degree.

SELECTION PROCESS

All applicants must sit for an admission test comprising MCQ, Written test and Viva-voce. The admission test is of 120 minutes; 60 minutes for the MCQ section and 60 minutes for the Written section. The question structure is given below:

MCQ Section Total Marks-80	English Proficiency (20 marks): Antonym, Synonym, Analogy, Substituting in a single word, Appropriate Preposition, Sentence Correction, Sentence Completion, Reading Comprehension Mathematics (30 marks): Arithmetic, Algebra, Geometry. Analytical Ability (20 marks): Analytical Ability and Critical Reasoning General Knowledge and Current Affairs (10 marks)
Written Section Total Marks-50	Translation (20 marks) Analytical Writing (15 marks) Descriptive Writing (15 marks)

The final merit list of students will be prepared according to the total marks obtained in the MCQ, Written test and Viva-voce. The Viva-voce will carry 20 marks.

Application Procedure and Schedule

One can apply both online and offline process. For applying online, visit the website (admission.bibm.org.bd). For Hardcopy Application, one can collect Application Form along with a Prospectus every day except public holiday during 10.00 am - 05.00 pm (03.00 pm - 09.00 pm for Friday and Saturday) on payment of Tk. 1000 from DSBM Office (3rd Floor, Academic Building).

Duration of the program is twenty-eight months. English is the medium of instruction in this program. Usually classes are held on Friday & Saturday.
